 Published November 12, 2015



The original SMPTE name for the project was "Studio Video over IP" (SVIP).

- A Drafting Group (DG) was created and given the name 32NF-60 DG (SVIP)
- The first SMPTE meeting of the DG was held Feb 18th 2016.



The name SMPTE ST 2110 was adopted the week of April 14th, 2016 (just prior to NAB).

ST 2110 Parts 10, 20, 21, 30 were published on SMPTE December 7, 2017.



2110 Update

As of today (Feb 26, 2019) the 2110 Drafting Group has held 139 meetings.
